Oct. to Nov. 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Dec. to Feb. 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

※ The park is open from 9:00 on weekends and holidays in February.

※ Last entry to the Flower Park is 30 minutes before closing time.

※ The park may be open at night during events.

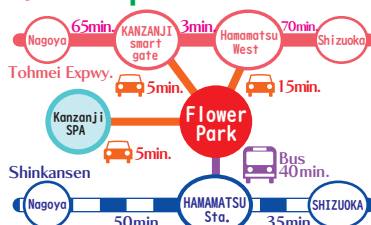
Entrance fees are subject to change based on the flowers blooming and seasonal changes.

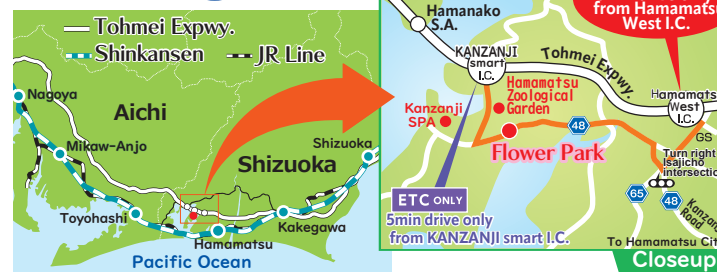

From the JR Hamamatsu Station North Gate, take the Entetsu Bus (Terminal 1) bound for Kanzanji Onsen. The ride takes about 40 minutes. Get off at the Flower Park bus stop.
